

## Amazon Creek Bank Stabilization Project *from Chambers Street to Garfield Street*

### **Project Location**

- Amazon Creek between Chambers Street and Garfield Street.

### **Project History**

- Historically the Amazon Creek was not a single creek, but a series of creek fingers and flooding areas.
- The Army Corps of Engineers channelized the Amazon Creek to provide flood control in the 1950s.



### **Project Overview**

- This project will stabilize eroded banks and make the bank slopes less steep.
- Thousands of native plants and seed mix will be added to enhance habitat potential.

### **Construction Schedule**

- Construction began summer 2013 and was suspended during the winter.
- Construction is planned to continue July through October 2014.

### **Traffic Impacts**

- Segments of the adjacent Fern Ridge Path will be temporarily closed during construction.
- Watch for construction signs and equipment.

### **Project Funding**

- City of Eugene Stormwater Utility Funds.
