

Paving Project Information

Fixing Eugene's Streets

West 1st Avenue, Madison Street, & Monroe Street Pavement Preservation Project

Paving of West 1st Avenue from the west side of Van Buren Street to the west side of Washington Street & Madison Street from the south side of West 1st Avenue to the north side of West 8th Avenue & Monroe Street from the south side of West 1st Avenue to the north side of Blair Boulevard.

Project Overview

- The existing pavement surface on West 1st Avenue and Madison Street will be ground off and repaved.
- The broken concrete pavement panels, failed asphalt pavement, and base rock on Monroe Street will be removed and replaced.
- The failed asphalt pavement and base rock on Madison Street will be removed and replaced.
- Most sidewalk access ramps will be reconstructed.

Construction Schedule

- Mid-June through September, 2014.
- Utility crews (gas, water) will work in the months before this paving project.

Traffic Impacts

- Watch for construction signs and equipment.
- Madison/Monroe: road work will close a few blocks at a time, requiring detours.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Project Funding

- The major funding source is the 2012 Street Bond.
- Other funding sources include the storm water and wastewater utility fees.
