

Paving Project Information

Fixing Eugene's Streets

Dillard Road, 43rd Avenue, Shasta Loop and Firland Boulevard Pavement Preservation Project *Paving from Amazon Drive to Spring Boulevard*

Project Overview

- The street is beginning to show age and loading-related deterioration. In order to prevent further deterioration and avoid more costly repairs, this street is planned to be rehabilitated by removing and replacing the top layers of asphalt pavement.
- The more severely deteriorated sections will require reconstruction of the base. This will be accomplished by rototilling cement in to the road base before repaving.
- Reconstructing sidewalk access ramps at most locations is also planned.



Construction Schedule

- The City awarded the project to Knife River Corporation.
- The contractor intends to begin work the week of July 1. The project is scheduled to be complete late Sept. 2014.
- Utility companies will continue to be in the project area adjusting and repairing their facilities prior to the City's project.

Traffic Impacts

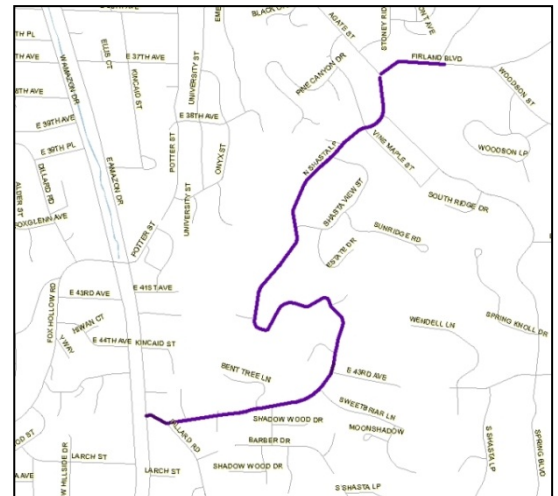
- Project phasing is yet to be determined.
