Marshall Avenue Pavement Preservation Project

Paving of Marshall Avenue from Echo Hollow Road to Hughes Street

Project Overview

- The street is beginning to show age and loading-related deterioration. In order to prevent further deterioration and avoid more costly repairs, this street is planned to be rehabilitated by removing and replacing the top layers of asphalt pavement.
- Reconstructing sidewalk access ramps at most locations is also planned.

Construction Schedule

- The City has awarded the project to Eugene Sand Construction.
- The contractor intends to begin work the week of June 16. The project is scheduled to be complete mid-August 2014.

Traffic Impacts

- Expect traffic delays and lane closures during construction and plan to use alternate streets to enter and exit your neighborhood.

Project Funding

- The major funding source is the 2012 Street Bond.
