## Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements Project At Various Locations

**Project Overview** - This project will construct bicycle and pedestrian improvements at various locations throughout the City:

- Construction of access ramps and a pedestrian refuge island with a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) on Green Acres Road near Delta Oaks Shopping Center.
- Construction of a bicycle access ramp on Amazon Parkway.
- Gate Improvements at the Lane County Fairgrounds.
- Construction of an access ramp at the Amazon Community Center.
- Construction of access ramps and installation of a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon at 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue and University Street.

### Construction Schedule

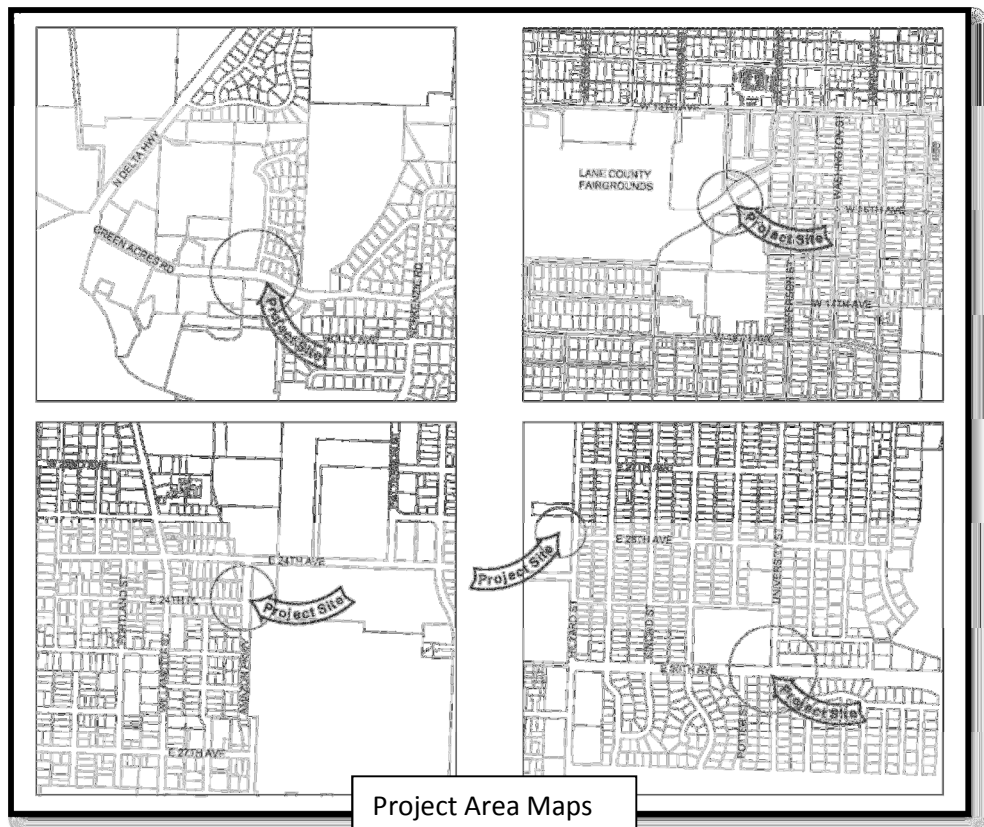
- June-August 2014.
