

Tobacco Cessation for the City of Eugene

Helping You Quit Tobacco for Good

Quitting tobacco is like learning to ride a bicycle. Nobody does it perfectly the first time, and it's easier with someone there to help you. Many people try to quit several times before they finally succeed.

How does the program work?

The Quit For Life® Program, brought to you by Alere Wellbeing and the American Cancer Society, is a six-month program that consists of phone-based, one-on-one treatment sessions with a professional Quit Coach®. During the initial call, which typically takes 25–30 minutes, your Quit Coach will review your tobacco use history and help you develop a personalized quit plan. If you're not quite ready to quit, your Quit Coach will work with you to get closer to making that decision. You can always call Quit For Life's toll-free number for additional support between your scheduled calls.

When you enroll in the Quit For Life® Program, you'll receive:

- One-on-one phone-based sessions scheduled at your convenience. These calls usually take 10–20 minutes.

- Unlimited toll-free telephone access to the Quit Coaches while you are in the program.
- Membership to Web Coach, where you can build your own Quitting Plan, track your progress, and interact with other participants and Quit Coaches.
- Recommended nicotine replacement products. If prescribed by your doctor, you may choose bupropion, bupropion SR, or Chantix instead of a nicotine replacement. Your copay applies. (Prescription is reimbursable using a Quick Claim Form.)
- A Quit Kit of materials designed to help you stay on track.

What if I start using tobacco again while I'm in the program?

The Quit For Life Quit Coaches are available by phone whenever you need them. Just as they helped you quit initially, they are there to help you get back on track if you start using tobacco again.

Who is eligible for the program?

This benefit is offered to all PacificSource members with medical coverage. There is no charge to participate in the program, and PacificSource covers unlimited quit attempts.

The Quit For Life® Program is brought to you by the American Cancer Society® and Alere Wellbeing.

How Do I Enroll?

You are not required to see your doctor to enroll, but doctor visits for tobacco cessation are covered under your plan. To enroll, simply call Quit For Life toll-free at (866) QUIT-4-LIFE (784-8454) or enroll online at www.quitnow.net. After you enroll, everything you need to participate will be sent directly to your home. A Quit Coach is available to serve your needs 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Other Tobacco Cessation Programs

If you participate in a tobacco cessation program other than Quit For Life, you will need to complete a Quick Claim Form and include the program information, and then submit the form to PacificSource for reimbursement.
