WHEREAS: Public works infrastructure, facilities and services are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life and the well-being of the people; and

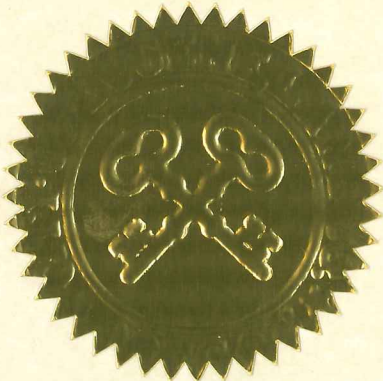
