Tip #3
**Store chicken and
animal feed in rat-
proof containers.**

Be a responsible urban farmer, pet owner, and neighbor! All animal feed **MUST** be kept in a rat-proof container. We recommend something metal, with a tight-fitting lid and no holes. Clean up uneaten pet and chicken food daily. www.eugene-or.gov/rats



Tip #4
Keep compost enclosed in a bin with a tight-fitting lid.

Be a good neighbor! Only compost your kitchen scraps in a self-contained tumbler or bin. If the bin is open on the bottom, line the ground with galvanized wire mesh with less than ¼” openings. (Chicken-wire isn’t strong enough to deter rodents.) www.eugene-or.gov/rats
