**WHEREAS:** The City of Eugene and the Pride Festival work to ensure that all Americans are treated equally regardless of sexual orientation or gender identification; and

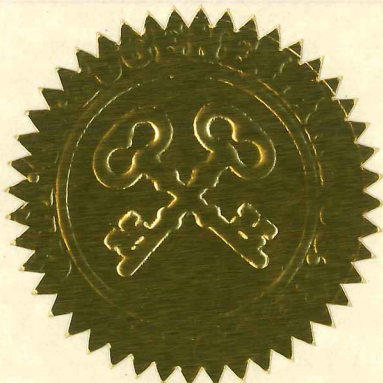
**WHEREAS:** The City of Eugene and the Pride Festival are committed to ensuring diversity, social justice, equality and mutual respect throughout our community; and
