## **Who is Protected?**

It is illegal for a landlord, real estate agent,  
lender or home insurer to treat people  
differently based on:

- Race or Color
- Religion
- Gender or Gender Identity
- Marital or Domestic Partnership Status
- Familial Status (children under 18)
- Physical or Mental Disability
- National Origin or Ethnicity\*
- Source of Income
- Survivors of Domestic Violence
- Sexual Orientation
- Age\*
