

Project Information Sheet

Balfour St, Calgary St, Elanco Ave, Terresa Ave, Quebec St, and Montreal Ave Paving

Project Overview:

- Work will occur on Balfour Street, Calgary Street, Terresa Avenue, Quebec Street, and Montreal Avenue.
- Work will also occur on Elanco Avenue and the adjacent cul-de-sac east of Norckenzie Road.
- These streets have deteriorated pavement due to age and traffic loading and need to be repaved.
- Work will also include installing or reconstructing 33 sidewalk access ramps at various intersections in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- This project is primarily intended to repair the street pavement, but additional work will be done to install new storm sewer on Montreal Ave to improve area drainage.

Construction Schedule:

- Work on this project has started and is expected to continue into September, 2019.
- Eugene Sand Construction has been hired for this work.

Traffic Impacts:

- Drivers should expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- On street parking may be restricted to accommodate construction activities.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work at the intersections.
- Bicyclists should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic depending on available lane widths during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the 2017 Street Preservation Bond.
