



Project Information Sheet

W 11th Avenue Pavement Preservation Project

Project Overview:

- The roadway between Bailey Hill Road and Oak Patch Drive has deteriorated pavement due to age and heavy traffic loading and need to be repaved.
- Stormwater treatment facilities will be modified between Commerce Street and Arthur Street.
- Work will also include reconstructing sidewalk access ramps throughout the project in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- Though this project is primarily intended to repair the street pavement, we have taken this opportunity to modify the stormwater facilities near the project limits to make them easier to maintain. The project also includes constructing a bike ramp on Seneca Street near W. 11th Avenue.

Construction Schedule:

- This project is scheduled to begin in late June and continue into October, 2019.
- Brown Contracting has been hired for this work.

Traffic Impacts:

- A majority of the work will be performed during night time hours, but daytime users will be impacted.
- Drivers should expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work at the intersections.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the 2017 Street Preservation Bond.
