Grant St, W 5th Ave, Lawrence St, Charnelton St, Olive St, E 3rd Ave and Mill St Pavement Preservation

Project Overview:

- Work will occur on:
 - Grant St from W 6th Avenue to W 5th Avenue.
 - W 5th Ave from Grant Street to Chambers Street.
 - Lawrence St from W 6th Avenue to Clark Street.
 - Charnelton St from W 6th Avenue to W 4th Avenue.
 - Oak St from E 6th Avenue to E 5th Avenue.
 - E 3rd Ave from Pearl Street to High Street.
 - Mill St from E 2nd Avenue to E 3rd Avenue.
- These streets have deteriorated pavement due to age and traffic loading and need to be repaved.
- Work will also include reconstructing sidewalk access ramps throughout the project in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- This project is primarily intended to repair the street pavement, but other work such as wastewater and stormwater repairs will be constructed as well.

Construction Schedule:

- This project is currently under construction and is expected to be completed by the end of July 2019.
- The city has contracted with Knife River Corporation – Northwest to perform the work.

Traffic Impacts:

- Drivers should expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- On street parking may be restricted to accommodate construction activities.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work at the intersections.
- Bicyclists should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic depending on available lane widths during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the 2017 Street Preservation Bond.
