



Project Information Sheet

Barger Drive Paving, Primrose Street to Altimont Street

Project Overview:

- This project is primarily intended to repair and rehabilitate the street pavement surface.
- This project will include changes to improve the safety, look, and feel of the busy corridor. Traffic signal modifications, lane configurations changes, median landscaping, and improvements for people who walk and bike will be completed as part of the project.

Construction Schedule:

- This project is underway and will continue into October, 2019.
- Wildish Construction is the contractor.
- Construction will continue in both daytime and periodic night time shifts in order to complete the work.

Traffic Impacts:

- A temporary speed zone reduction to 25mph is in place for the duration of the project.
- Drivers should continue to expect delays during construction.
- Drivers will experience expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work at the intersections.
- Bicyclists should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the 2012 Voter Approved Bond Measure to Fix Streets.
