

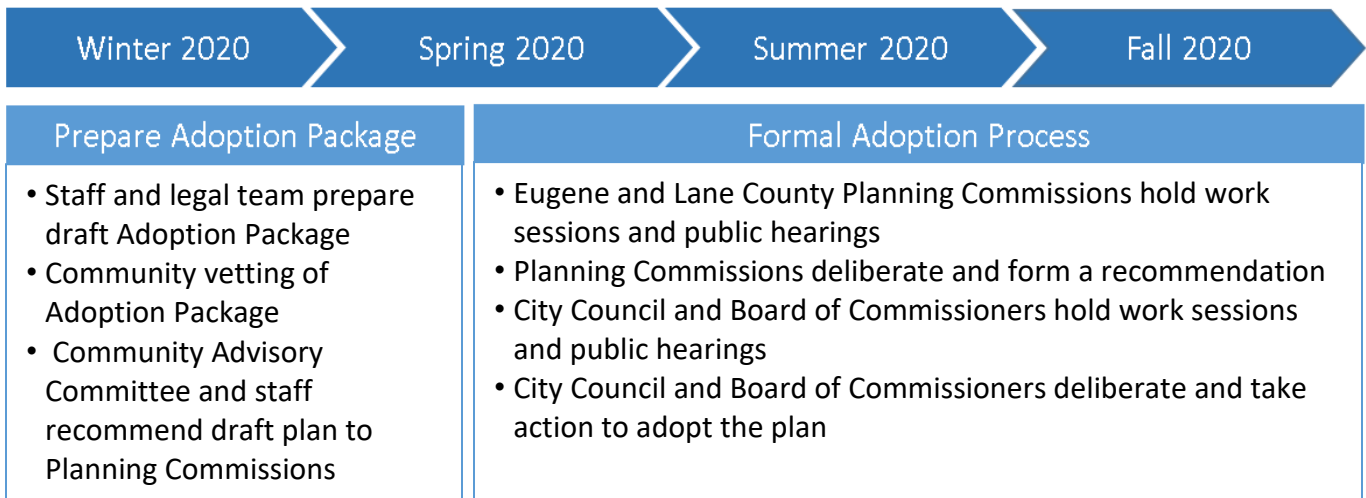
NEXT STEPS FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN

After we finalize the action plan based on input received tonight, at other meetings, and through the online survey, the next step is the Adoption Process!

This winter, staff and the Community Advisory Committee will go to the Eugene City Council and the Lane County Board of Commissioners. We will share our work so far, including the draft goals, policies and action plan. If they initiate the adoption process we will start putting together the adoption package, which includes legal review and getting community input on all of the components, such as new zones and land use code changes.

Community input will continue throughout the adoption process through newsletter updates, involvement of the neighborhood associations (RRCO and SCCO), community information sessions, mailed notices, and outreach to residents and property owners. The volunteer Community Advisory Committee will also stay involved and continue serve as a liaison between neighbors and the planning process.
