AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN UPDATED EUGENE AIRPORT MASTER PLAN, A REFINEMENT PLAN OF THE EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD METROPOLITAN AREA GENERAL PLAN (METRO PLAN); ADOPTING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN UPDATED EUGENE AIRPORT MASTER PLAN, A REFINEMENT PLAN OF THE EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD METROPOLITAN AREA GENERAL PLAN (METRO PLAN); ADOPTING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE CITY OF EUGENE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Eugene Airport Master Plan set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein is adopted as a refinement plan to the Transportation Element of the Metro Plan to supersede and replace the previous version of the Eugene Airport Master Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 20463.

Section 2. Although not part of this Ordinance, the City Council adopts the findings set forth in the attached Exhibit B in support of this action.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 4. Notwithstanding the effective date of ordinances as provided in the Eugene Charter of 2002, this Ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the date of passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor, or upon the date the Lane County Board of Commissioners has taken action substantively identical to the action taken by the City of Eugene in Section 1 of this ordinance.
