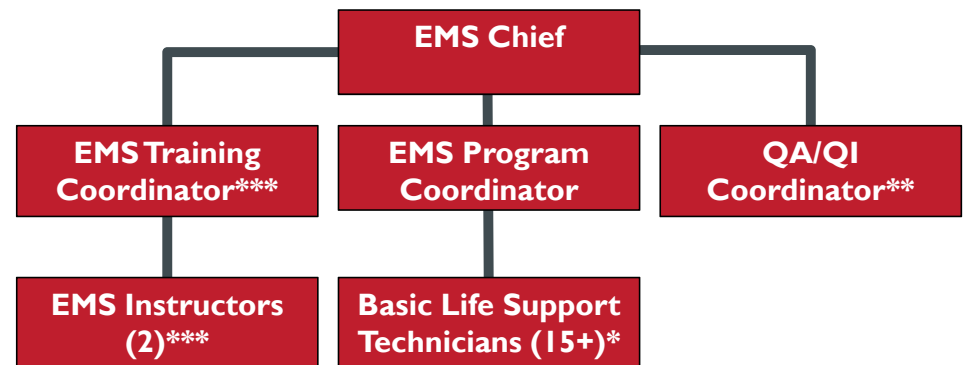

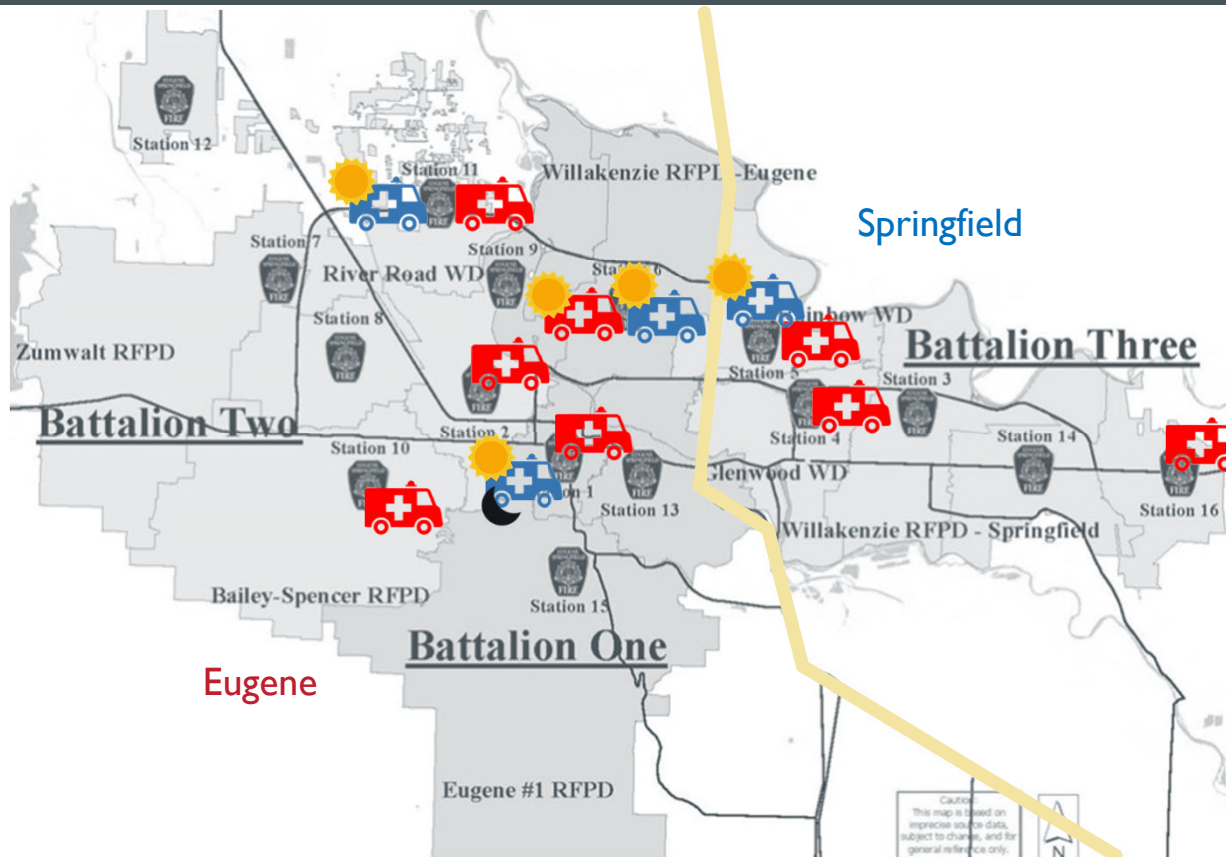
## Advantages of Consolidation

- Consistency in Training, Protocols, and System Operation.
- One supervising physician.
- Interoperability.

## Challenges of Consolidation

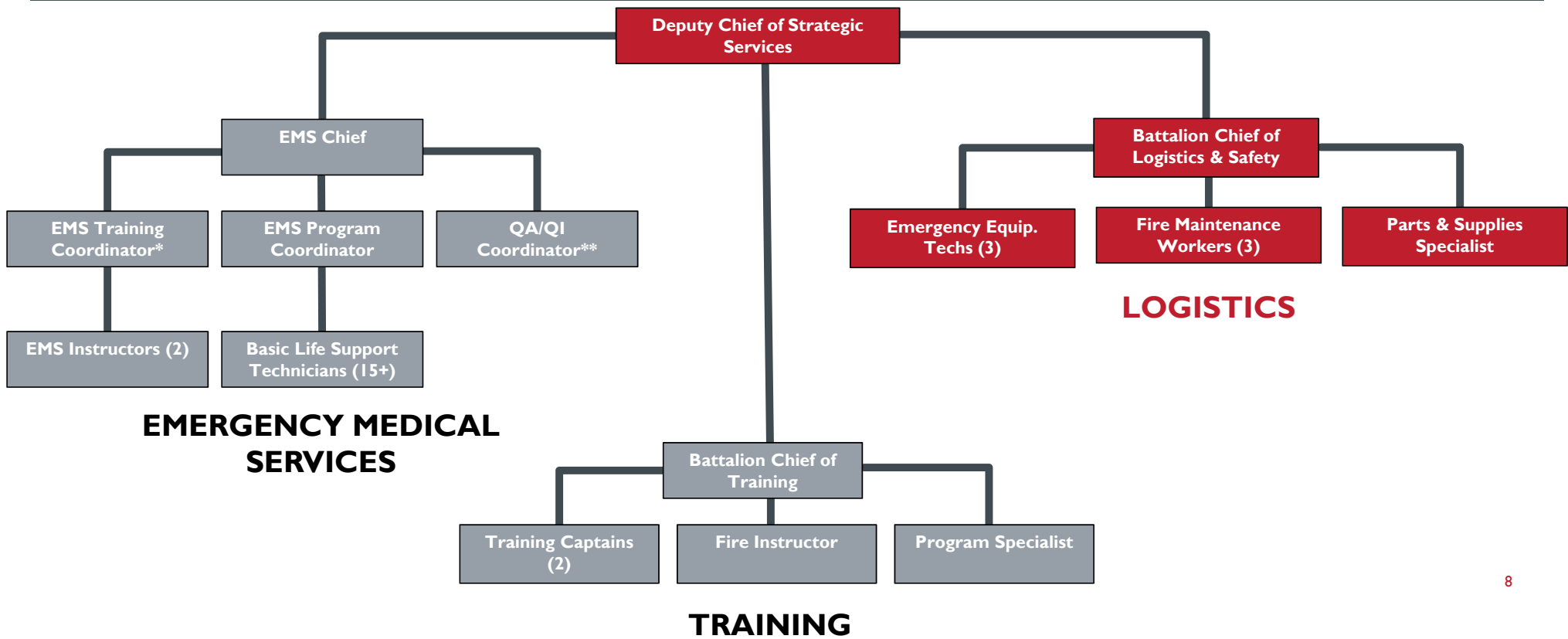
- Low number of administrative staff.
- Duality of system (ex: licensure, contracts, purchasing).
- Shared liability.
- Differing policies and directives by city (ex: COVID-19).
- Ambulance deployment is based on ATF rather than efficiency.
  - 2 ATFs

# HISTORICAL AMBULANCE DEPLOYMENT



- 2015** – 6 ALS Ambulances, 4 #ALS Day Ambulance Deployed
- 2016** – 2 BLS Day Ambulances Added, 4 ALS Day Ambulance Removed (Eugene)
- 2017** – 4 BLS Ambulance Added (Eugene)
- 2018** – 4 ALS Ambulance Added (Eugene)
- 2019** – 4 BLS Day Ambulance Reassigned (Springfield)

# LOGISTICS

## Advantages of Consolidation

- “One Stop Shop” for Fire and EMS needs.
  - Efficiency.
  - Immediate service.
- Certified and trained personnel for repair and testing of fire equipment and PPE.

## Challenges of Consolidation

- Complexity in tracking supply billing and costs. (No COS Backstock)
- Buildings, facilities, tools, personnel (except 4 FTE), and fuel are paid for by the COE.
- Staffing has not increased to match increased workload of serving two cities.
- Different purchasing procedures.
- Separate apparatus maintenance procedures.
- SharePoint Safety Site Migration
- Alignment of funding streams for large capital purchases.
  - Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA)
  - Radios
