

NOTICE OF INTENDED AMENDMENT OF THE PARKING FEE SCHEDULE

To: The Mayor and City Councilors, and other interested persons.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 5 and Section 2.020 of the Eugene, Code, 1971, the City Manager of the City of Eugene intends to amend the following fees contained in the Parking Fee Schedule that were adopted by Administrative Order No. 53-10-07-F:

Amendments to the Parking Fee Schedule are necessary due to the addition and removal of surface parking lots, and in order to recover the City's costs of parking operations. In determining the fees, consideration has been given to the applicable policies, enactments and directives of the City Council, the amount charged for these services by the City in the past, the full costs of providing these services supported by the fees, the amounts charged by other comparable providers, and the revenue needs of the City as determined by the adopted City budget. In addition, the applicable criteria of Section 5.055 and Subsection 5.285(7) of the Eugene Code, 1971, have been considered.

Comments or objections to the proposed fee amendments must be submitted in writing to Jeff Petry, Parking Services Manager, Planning & Development Department, 99 West 10th

Avenue, Eugene, Oregon 97401, within 15 days from the date of posting as indicated below. After expiration of the comment period, the City Manager will consider the comments received and, by administrative order, adopt the fees as proposed or as modified in response to comments received, provided that any modified fees comply with the provisions of the Eugene Code, 1971.
